



NNS Membership Requirement

A. Student Membership (SNNS)

Undergraduate students enrolled in Science, Engineering and Technology Faculties of a tertiary institution recognized by the NNS Council are eligible to apply. A letter of recommendation or introduction from any senior staff member of the institution is required. Active Student Members will find the society an exciting platform to grow and connect!

B. Associate Membership (MNNS)

This category covers applicants who are not graduates of any core area of nuclear or radiation science, engineering and technology and do not professionally specialize or work in a nuclear related field. Secondary School teachers in the Sciences and Technology who do not meet the requirements for Full Membership may be eligible here. A Degree Qualification (Bachelor of HND) will be required. Except for eligibility to hold office in the NNS Council, active Associate Members will enjoy all rights and privileges of membership and will find the society an inspiring environment to grow!

C. Full Membership (MNNS)

Applicants for full membership must possess at least a Degree (Bachelor or HND) in any Nuclear Related Field, Science, Engineering or Technology or should professionally specialize or work in a Nuclear Related Field. Registration in this category grants full active-membership rights and privileges including the right to serve in the NNS Council. This category offers a rich experience of inclusivity participation!

D. Life Membership (ANNS)

Life Membership of the NNS is for only those qualified as Full Members and have at least a Second Degree (MSc etc). Life members enjoy all rights and privileges of Full Membership including serving in the NNS Council. The Validity of Life Membership Registration is however for a lifetime with no need for payment of annual membership renewal fees. Life membership assure long term stable contribution!

E. Corporate Membership (CNNS)

This category is for any organization operating in, encouraging, supporting and/or promoting the peaceful application of Nuclear Energy. Corporate Membership confers on such organization some rights and privileges of Full Membership and some extra privileges. Corporate Members are however not eligible to hold office in the NNS Council. The society provide a huge corporate outlet for participation in building the industry for this category of membership!
